

Pittsford swim team excels at Webster invitational

The Pittsford girls' junior varsity team finished its winning season on Oct. 24 at the Webster JV Invitational. Swimming against nine other Section V teams, multiple swimmers won their events and achieved best times of the season.

First-place winners included Lauren Romanick in the 100-yard freestyle, Becca Flisnik in the 100-yard breaststroke, Emily Torpey in the 200- and 500-yard freestyles and Sabrina Wesley in the 100-yard fly and 200 individual medley.

Pittsford also won all three relays at the meet. This included the 200-medley relay of Sarah Cooper, Caroline Hanson, Wesley and Romanick. Annie Chen, Flisnik, Wesley and Romanick won the 200-yard freestyle relay and Chen, Hanson, Carolyn Allen and Torpey won the 400-yard freestyle relay.

Second-place winners at this meet included Romanick in the 50-yard freestyle, Chen in the 200-yard individual medley, Cooper in 100-yard breaststroke and Anna Pogharian in the 100-yard fly. Other top 10 winners were Chloe Lang in 100-yard fly and 200 individual medley, Brianna Raskin in the 200-yard individual medley, Hayley Gallant in 500-yard freestyle, Carolyn Allen and Caroline Hanson in the 100-yard freestyle and Annie Chen and Anna Pogharian in 100-yard backstroke.

Several swimmers achieved personal in-season best times including Isabella High and Samantha Morrell in the 50-yard freestyle, Colette Fraser and Ana Maria Alvarado in the 100-yard freestyle and Kali MacLean and Isha Kenkare in the 100-yard breaststroke. Ninth-grader Morgan McGrath completed her diving season with a great finish.
