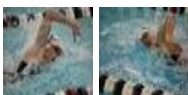

Pittsford swimming and diving has dominated Section V this year, winning all of its dual meets and scoring big victories at the New Hartford and Empire Invitational meets.

In the last three weeks, the S'Women broke pool records that have existed for five, 10, 15 and even 26 years. All-Americans Katie Smith (50 and 100 free) and Lindsay Stone (200 and 500 free) led the way by helping break more than 30 statewide pool records this season.

Members of the record-breaking 200 and 400 freestyle relays included Emma Corby, Becca Evans and Maddie Holodnik, with others contributing. The 200 medley relay also saw pool records from the combined efforts of Katie Drake, Bianca Lopez, Anne Marie Mozrall and Stephanie Riley. Additional pool records have fallen in diving by Maddie Schaefer.

The strength and depth of the team was exemplified recently at Victor in the 500 free when all four S'Women beat the 2013 pool record of 5:23. Lindsay Stone clocked in at 5:00, Katie Drake at 5:15, Kelly Knickerbocker at 5:16 and Annie Birmingham at 5:20.
